Ben C. Baer is Assistant Professor of Comparative Literature at Princeton University. Work in progress includes a book manuscript, *Vanguard and Voice: Literary Modernism and the Colonial World, 1920s-1940s*, which looks at the relations between the politics and poetics of “voice” in representations of the didactic mission of political vanguards. He has also translated Tarashankar Bandopadhyay’s *Hansuli Banker Upakatha* (The Tale of Hansuli Turn, forthcoming Columbia University Press), which is one of the key novels of mid-twentieth century Bengali literature. Ben Baer has recently published essays in *Rethinking Marxism*, *The Journal of Humanities and Social Sciences*, and the Bengali-language journal *Gangeo-Patra*.
